

Log in IHIP web portal

To log in to the IHIP web portal as a Health Facility user, follow these steps:

- Launch your preferred web browser.
- Go to the IHIP web portal by entering the URL: <https://ihip.nhp.gov.in>
- On the homepage, locate the left box and click on "Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme"



- or directly enter the URL "ihip.nhp.gov.in/idsp" in the browser's address bar and press enter.
- You will be directed to the IDSP module homepage within the IHIP portal.





Each Yatra Health Center / Facility will have one identified Medical Officer In-charge, serving as the Nodal person for reporting, even if there are multiple Medical Officers on duty.

i. Yatra Case Form:

This form must be completed daily by users at every Yatra Health Center for every patient. The web page consists of various components, which are briefly explained in the following screenshot and further detailed in the accompanying text.

- You will also find an "Add Patient" button, which allows you to start entering data for a new case or death. More details about this will be discussed in the next subsection.
- The page also, displays a summary of the "Total OPD cases for the day" and "Total IPD cases for the day." This is auto calculated summary of the submitted records for the days.
- Below, the patient data entry section, two tables are presented: the first table shows the line list of cases, and the second table shows the line list of deaths.
- At the bottom of the page, you will find the "Submit Records" button. Clicking on this button allows you to submit the batch of case records that you have saved or updated.

Now, let's understand the process of entering data for a new case:

- By default, the "Yatri" option is selected. If the patient is a registered traveler for the Amarnath Yatra, click on "Search Yatri ID" and enter the Yatri ID. Clicking on "Get Details" will automatically fetch the patient's details based on their registration ID.
- If the patient is not a traveler for the Amarnath Yatra, click on "Other" to proceed. In that case, you need to fill in the patient's demographic details under the "Patient Details" box, especially the mandatory fields marked with a red asterisk *.
- Once 'Patient Details' is filled, then proceed to fill in the "Clinical Details".

After adding a case, it will be listed under the "List of Reported Cases" at the bottom. If needed, you can still make changes by clicking the "Edit" button. Once all cases have been saved and verified, click the "Submit Records" button to send the records to the server. This allows users at the district, state, and national levels to access the records and any related analytics. Upon clicking "Submit Records," a confirmation message will appear. If further changes are required, click "No"; otherwise, click "Yes" to submit the records. After clicking "Yes," a message will confirm the successful submission of records.

The screenshot below displays all available reports for users of the Yatra Health Center, including those at the District, State, and National levels who have access to this feature. These reports hold significant importance, especially for the control room team responsible for taking swift

action in response to unexpected events, such as a surge in cases of one or more diseases. By utilizing these reports, the control room team can promptly address such situations at an early stage.

- i. **Yatra Form Summary:** The Yatra Form Summary feature provides a comprehensive overview of the data collected through the Yatra Case Form within a specified date range for the health center. Additionally, users at the District, State, and National levels have the ability to delve deeper into the data by narrowing it down to a specific zone or health center. The summary offers insights into the health condition of patients across two age groups (≤ 15 years and > 15 years), including information on cases referred to a higher facility. Furthermore, it presents a gender-wise summary of deaths.

ii. **Yatra Health Conditions Summary:** The Yatra Health Conditions Summary report provides a concise overview of aggregate numbers, date-wise, categorized by health condition, for a selected range of dates. It allows users to modify the zones and health conditions to suit their needs. Report can be drilled down to a particular health condition and up to health facility level. The report also includes a date-wise trend analysis of Outpatient Department (OPD) cases, Inpatient Department (IPD) cases. Additionally, it presents the day-wise trend of health conditions in a bar diagram format and showcases the distribution of all cases through a pie diagram.




